

# ARTWORK FILE GUIDELINES

## NOTES:

**Acceptable File Formats:** .ai, .pdf, or .eps

- Must be designed in a vector based program such as Adobe Illustrator to ensure high resolution. If saving as PDF, save as “Press Quality” to retain resolution.
- Do not change the dimensions of the provided dieline template.
- Do not flatten the dieline template, leave in vector form.
- Additional finishes such as foil stamping, embossing, Spot UV, etc., must be in separate layers with proper naming.

Document Mode: CMYK

All Black Type Set to 100% K ONLY

All links embedded

All fonts converted to outlines

1/8" bleed if content runs off box

Unused or hidden layers/elements removed

All layers and content unlocked

All art in 1-3 layers

Dieline/Template on it's own layer on top

Barcodes in vector format
